ELIGIBILITY AND SELECTION CRITERIA:

- 1 Students may apply for scholarships when they have started the application process for admission to the university. A completed admissions application must be attached to the scholarship application
- 2 Submit a scholarship application to the Office of Admissions along with an essay (excluding high school scholarship applicants). The essay should answer the following: <u>Life can be full of challenges and obstacles.</u>
 <u>Discuss a time when a challenge or obstacle stood between you and your goal and how you responded.</u>
 Alternately, this essay can describe how someone else met a challenge or overcame and obstacle to accomplish a goal (300-600 words).
- 3 It is the student's responsibility to ensure all required information and documents required for the respective scholarship are included with his or her scholarship application. Incomplete scholarship applications will be determined as ineligible. All scholarship applications need to be submitted no later than the end of the student's first term of enrollment.
- 4 Students must be enrolled, in good standing with the university and meet Satisfactory Academic Progress to receive a scholarship disbursement; 90% Attendance and 2.75 GPA (except FIRST Robotics and CyberPatriot which requires a minimum 3.0 GPA for renewal).
- 5 The scholarship is distributed and applied equally over academic years, and cannot be combined with other Hallmark scholarships or create a negative account balance.
- The Hallmark Scholarship is applicable to tuition and fees only for a Hallmark degree program and is not transferrable to other programs and schools. Registration fees, tools, books, and lab charges (if applicable), are required to be paid by the student and will vary according to the course of study.

Scholarship Eligibility Criteria:

a. Hallmark Alumni Family (Legacy) Scholarship:

- i. Awarded each year
- ii. \$2k/\$4k (AAS/BS)
- iii. *Criteria:*
 - 1. Applicant has one biological or adoptive parent, or legal guardian who is a Hallmark Alumnus/a.

b. Hallmark Cyber Patriot Scholarship:

- i. Awarded each year
- ii. \$7500/\$15000 (AAS/BS)
- iii. Criteria:
 - 1. Current Calendar Year High School Graduate
 - 2. Participant on a CyberPatriot team during the past school year.
 - 3. Must maintain a 3.0 GPA and 90% attendance to renew scholarship each academic year.

c. Hallmark FIRST Robotics Scholarship:

- i. 5 awarded per year
- ii. \$3k/\$6k (AAS/BS)
- iii. *Criteria*:
 - 1. Team member of FRC competition team within the past year
 - 2. Certified copy of high school transcripts
 - 3. Must maintain 3.0 GPA and 90% attendance to renew the scholarship each academic year

d. Hallmark High School Scholarship:

- i. No limit per year
- ii. \$2k/\$4k (AAS/BS)
- iii. Criteria:
 - 1. Recent High School graduate
 - 2. HU must be first college or university to have been enrolled in within two (2) terms

e. Hallmark Veteran Family Scholarship:

- i. 5 awarded per year
- ii. \$3k/\$6k (AAS/BS)
- iii. Criteria:
 - 1. Immediate family member of a US Military Veteran or Active Duty (i.e. spouse, child, or grandchild)
 - 2. Optional: One letter of recommendation (teacher, counselor, employer)

f. Hallmark Women in IT Scholarship:

- i. 5 awarded per year
- ii. \$2k/\$4k (AAS/BS)
- iii. Criteria:
 - 1. Be a female applicant enrolling into one of the Information Technology Programs

g. Hallmark Women in Aviation Scholarship:

- i. 5 awarded per year
- ii. \$2k/\$4k (AAS/BS)
- iii. Criteria:
 - 1. Be a female applicant enrolling into one of the Aeronautics Programs

h. CCDC (Collegiate Cyber Defense Competition) Scholarship:

- i. Limited per year
- ii. Various amounts awarded per year
- iii. Criteria:
 - 1. Cybersecurity professional, or high performing CyberPatriot team member selected by CCDC committee.
 - 2. Participation on Hallmark University's Collegiate Cyber Defense Competition team while eligible.

i. Charles Taylor Aviation Maintenance Leadership Scholarship:

- i. Maximum of 21 credits
- ii. *Criteria*:
 - 1. Be an AAS graduate of Hallmark College School of Aeronautics
 - 2. Be enrolling into BS program (BSBA) to obtain pre-requisites to enter the Bachelors of Aviation Maintenance Management Program
 - 3. Scholarship will be applied after completion of the first Academic Year of BSAM Program

j. Martin Luther King (MLK) Scholarship:

- i. Limited per year
- ii. Various amounts awarded per year
- iii. Criteria:
 - 1. Recent Calendar Year High School Graduate
 - 2. Be a minority student of Black/African-American, Hispanic, Asian, or Native American ethnicity
 - 3. Be eligible for a Federal Pell Grant (establishes financial need)
 - 4. One letter of recommendation (teacher, counselor, employer, pastor, etc.)
 - 5. Certified copy of high school transcripts

k. C-12 Scholarship:

- i. No limit per year
- ii. \$15k (\$3,750/AY)
- iii. *Criteria:*
 - 1. Central Texas C12 Member (Employer)
 - 2. C12 Company has some form of tuition reimbursement policy
 - 3. Supervisor letter of support for employee to enroll in an HU program
 - 4. C12 company willingness to participate in Hallmark University advisory committees as appropriate, to improve HU's academic programs

I. CommuniCare Scholarship:

- i. No limit per year
- ii. \$26k (\$6,500/AY)
- iii. Criteria:
 - 1. Employed full time (30+ hours per week) and in good standing with CommuniCare Health Centers.
 - 2. Employed with CommuniCare Health Centers without interruption a minimum of 90 days
 - 3. Immediate family member of a current employee of CommuniCare Health Centers. Immediate family member is defined as a spouse, child, or stepchild.
 - 4. High School graduate/GED
 - 5. Certified copy of high school transcripts

m. Rotary Scholarship:

- i. 5 awarded per year
- ii. \$3k/\$6k (AAS/BS)
- iii. Criteria:
 - 1. Current Calendar Year High School Graduate
 - 2. Diploma Plus recipient (verification by Rotary Club of San Antonio)
 - 3. One letter of recommendation (teacher, counselor, employer, pastor, etc.)
 - 4. Certified copy of high school transcripts

n. Summer Intensive Scholarship:

- i. No limit per year
- ii. \$2,500/\$5k (AAS/BS)
- iii. Criteria:
 - 1. Completed Hallmark University Summer Intensive Program
 - 2. One letter of recommendation (teacher, counselor, employer, etc.)
